Re: 2022-2023 Transportation during emergencies/inclement weather

The following information is for CCESC contracted transportation for closures due to emergencies **INCLUDING COVID 19/Public Health**, or inclement weather. It applies to all public, vocational, charter, renaissance, nonpublic and private schools.

- For COVID-19 CLOSURES, schools/districts MUST notify the bus company and the CCESC of the closure dates.
- For weather related closings, all students will be transported to their respective schools unless the school or district designee notifies the bus company. Bus companies should know by <u>5:00 AM</u> that schools are closed. If a bus leaves the yard, appropriate charges will be incurred by the school district.
- If a school district is closed, students from that district <u>WILL NOT</u> be transported, regardless of the destination school's status.
- It is the school district/school's responsibility to communicate with parents about the route status for student's on shared routes.
- SEE CHART BELOW FOR TRANSPORTATION SCENARIOS.

The following procedures will be in effect to implement the directives above.

 If a destination school/district is closed or on delayed opening, the destination school/district designee has the responsibility to call all bus companies transporting their students and advise them accordingly. Bus companies will adjust their schedule to accommodate the closing or delayed opening at the destination school.

- If a student's resident school district is closed and the destination school is open, students from the resident school district will <u>not</u> be transported. Bus companies have responsibility to identify the status of resident school districts and adjust schedules accordingly. For bus routes transporting students from multiple resident school districts, buses are to be cancelled only if all resident school districts on the route are closed.
- Early dismissals will be communicated by the school/district designee to the bus companies servicing their schools.

Bus Companies: For consolidated routes covering multiple districts/schools/municipalities: If ANY district/school of residence on the route is DELAYED, the route will operate on a delayed opening based on the LATEST delay, even if ANY district of residence or attendance is open on time. It is the responsibility of the district/school of attendance to notify their students on the route.

Schools/Districts: It is your responsibility to notify the bus companies AND YOUR STUDENTS of your closing/delayed opening/early dismissal status.

Camden County Educational Services Commission will update route information weekly during the winter for those schools/districts that have students from multiple districts of residence on a consolidated route. It is the responsibility of the school/district to develop a student notification for those routes.
